Why are leaders and managers both important?

- * Projects fail all the time – why?
 - ✓ Schedules slip, budgets get overrun – management issues
 - ✓ Team cannot cope with change – leadership issue

- * “Most U.S. corporations . . . are overmanaged and underled.”
 - ✓ Professor John Kotter, Harvard Business School

- * Both leaders and managers are necessary

What is a Leader?

- * Someone who creates a vision
- * Someone who builds trust with others
- * Someone who is followed by others
 - ✓ But followers are free to stop at any time

What else?

What is a Manager?

- * Someone with authority over a unit or group
- * Responsible for ensuring smooth operation
- * Someone who has subordinates, not followers

What else?

Managing vs. Leading

- * There is a difference between managing and leading
 - ✓ Not everyone can excel at both
 - ✓ However, executives can and should develop at both over time

- * Managers:
 - ✓ Help team cope with complexity
 - ✓ Engage in planning, budgeting
 - ✓ Organize and staff team
 - ✓ Control and problem solve

- * Leaders:
 - ✓ Help team cope with change
 - ✓ Set direction
 - ✓ Align team to vision
 - ✓ Motivate and inspire

Complexity vs. Change

* Managers: Help team cope with complexity

- ✓ Complexity that is not addressed leads to chaos
- ✓ Effective management helps replace chaos with order
- ✓ Effective management brings consistency to processes

* Leaders: Help team cope with change

- ✓ Fast change is inevitable in the modern business climate
- ✓ The more change takes place, the more leadership is required
- ✓ Effective leadership keeps team on the path despite changes

Planning vs. Setting Direction

* Managers: Plan & budget

- ✓ Set targets and goals
- ✓ Lay out the plan for meeting targets and goals
- ✓ Allocate resources toward the targets and goals

* Leaders: Set a direction

- ✓ Develop a vision of the future
- ✓ Develop strategy to produce changes needed to achieve the vision

Organizing vs. Aligning

- * Managers: Organize & staff
 - ✓ Build structure of jobs and reporting relationships
 - ✓ Train the team
 - ✓ Communicate plans
 - ✓ Decide how much authority to delegate and to whom
- * Leaders: Align to vision
 - ✓ Talk to people about the vision
 - ✓ Get them to comprehend the vision
 - ✓ Empower people to participate in achieving the vision

Problem Solving vs. Inspiring

- * Managers: Solve problems
 - ✓ Compare planned and actual performance and document variances
 - ✓ Raise the alarm when variances signal major risks or issues
 - ✓ Make sure that quality lapses are corrected
- * Leaders: Inspire team
 - ✓ Satisfy human needs for achievement
 - ✓ Recognize and reward success
 - ✓ Cultivate strong networks of informal relationships
