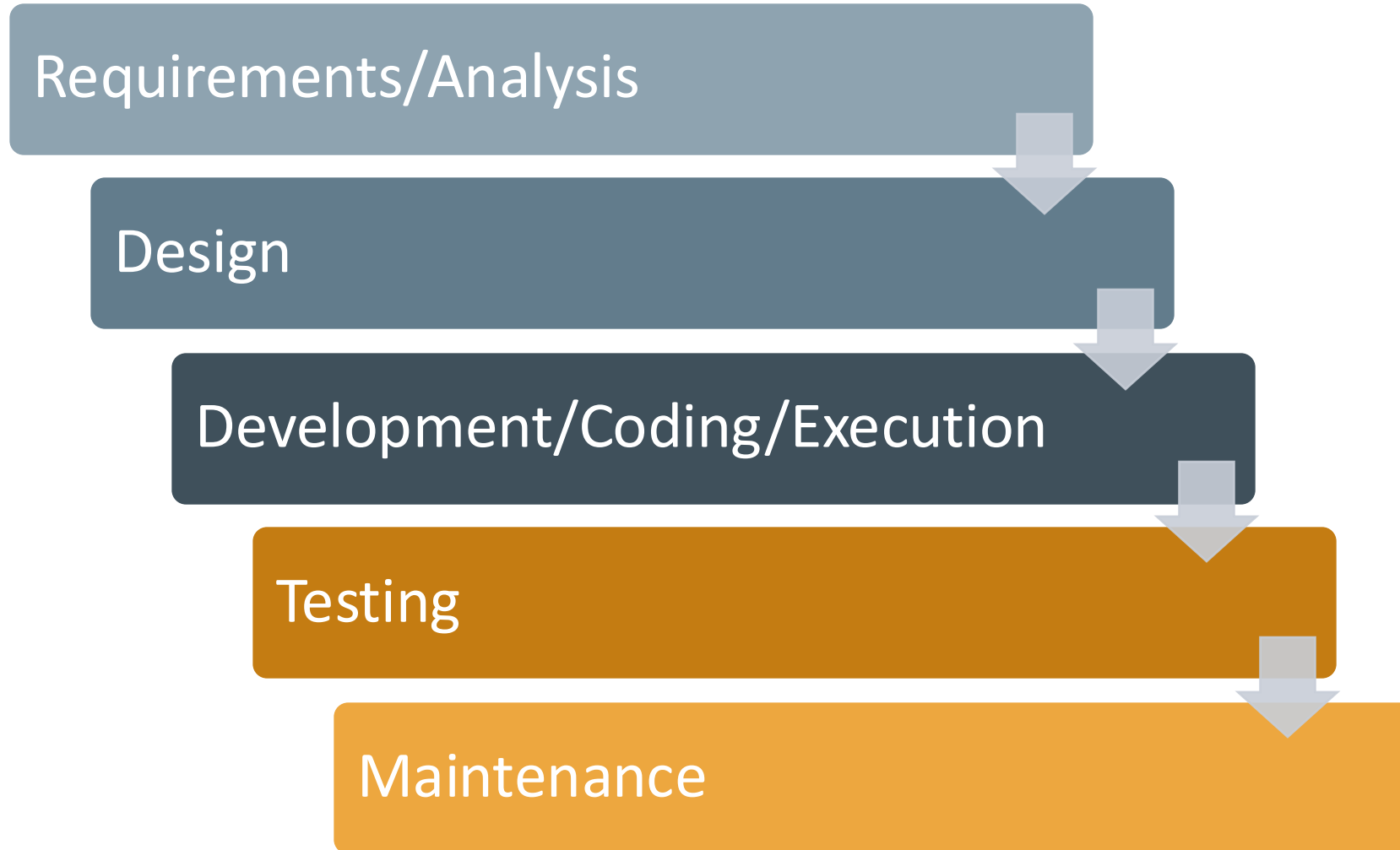

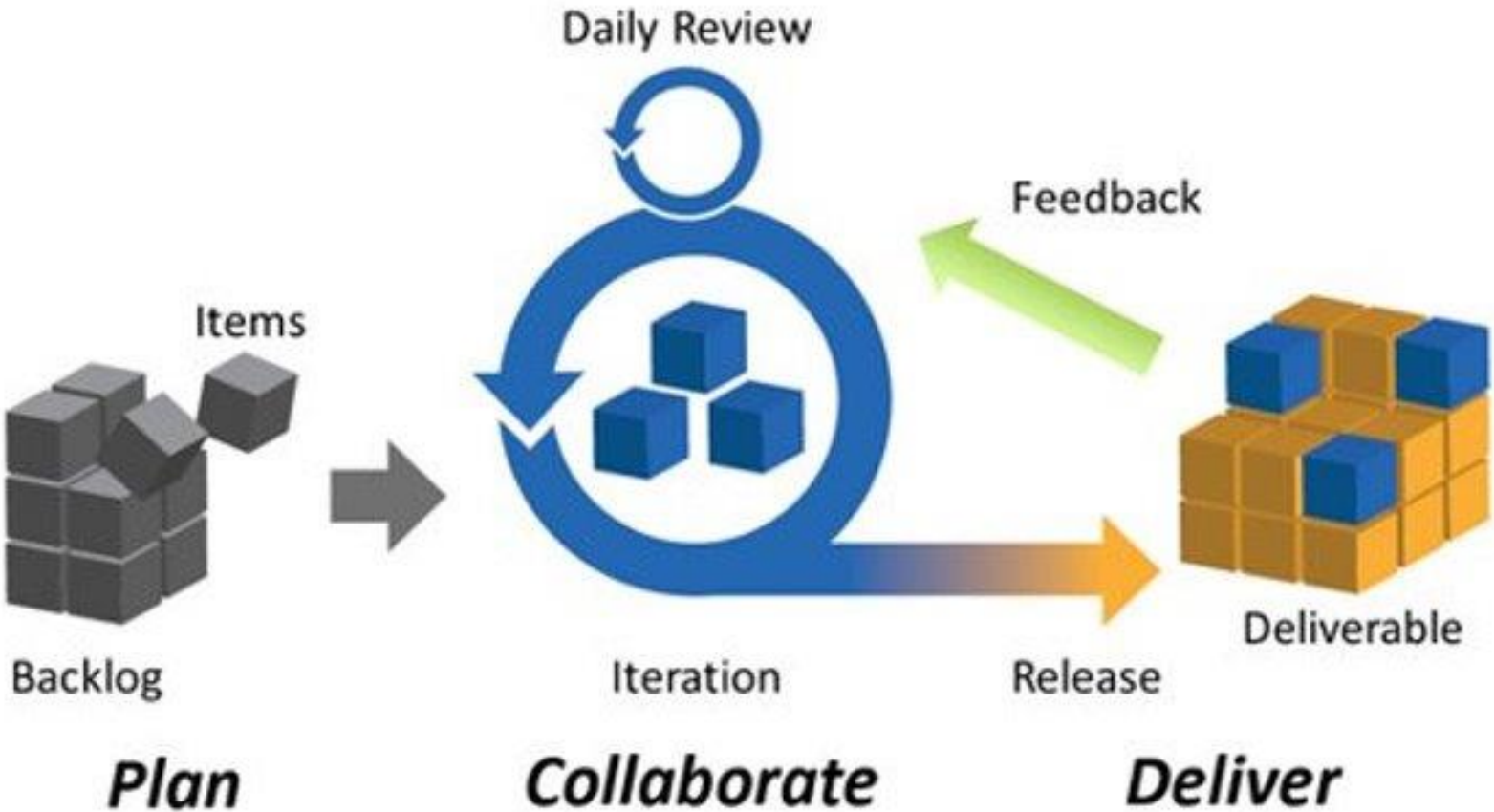

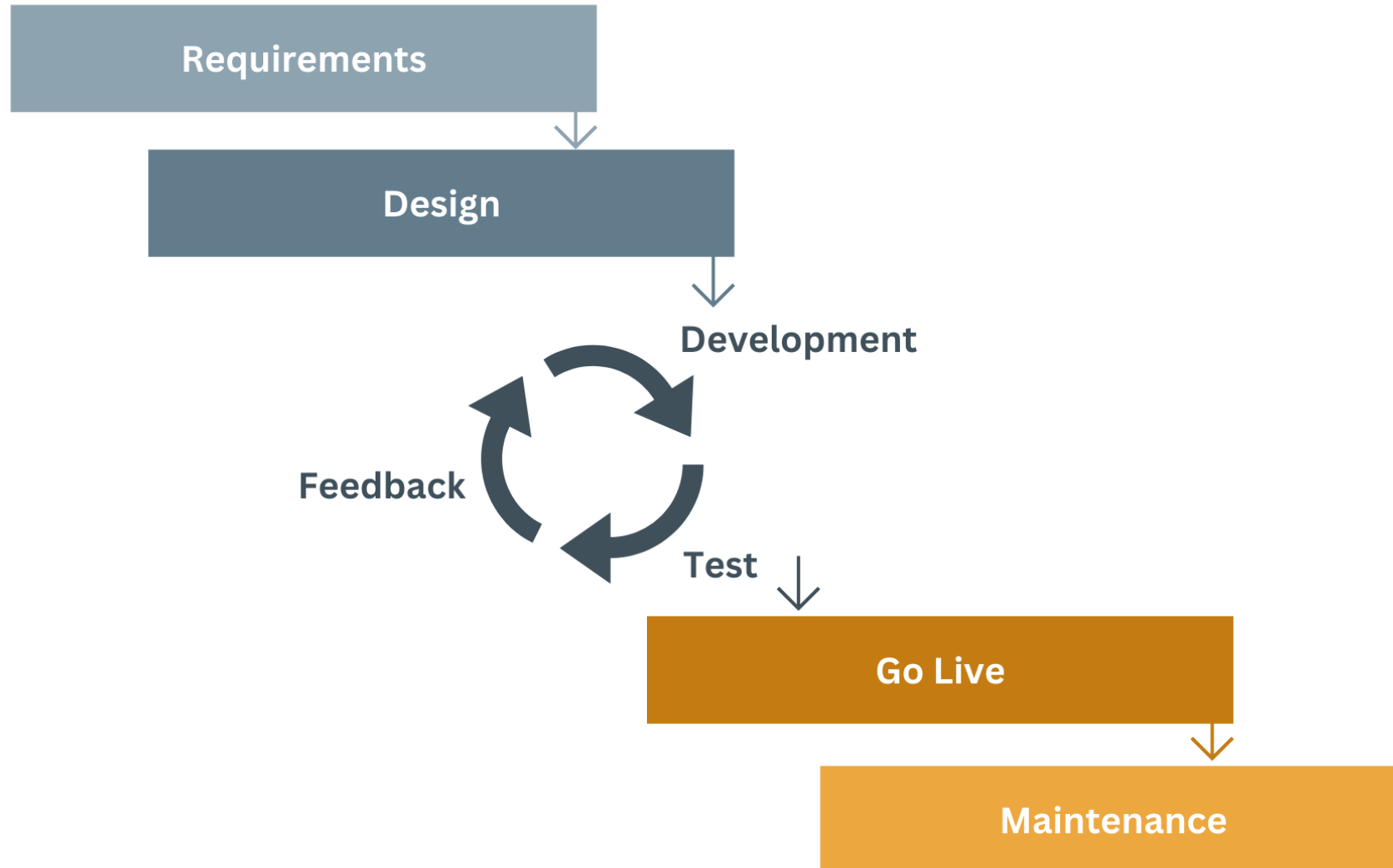

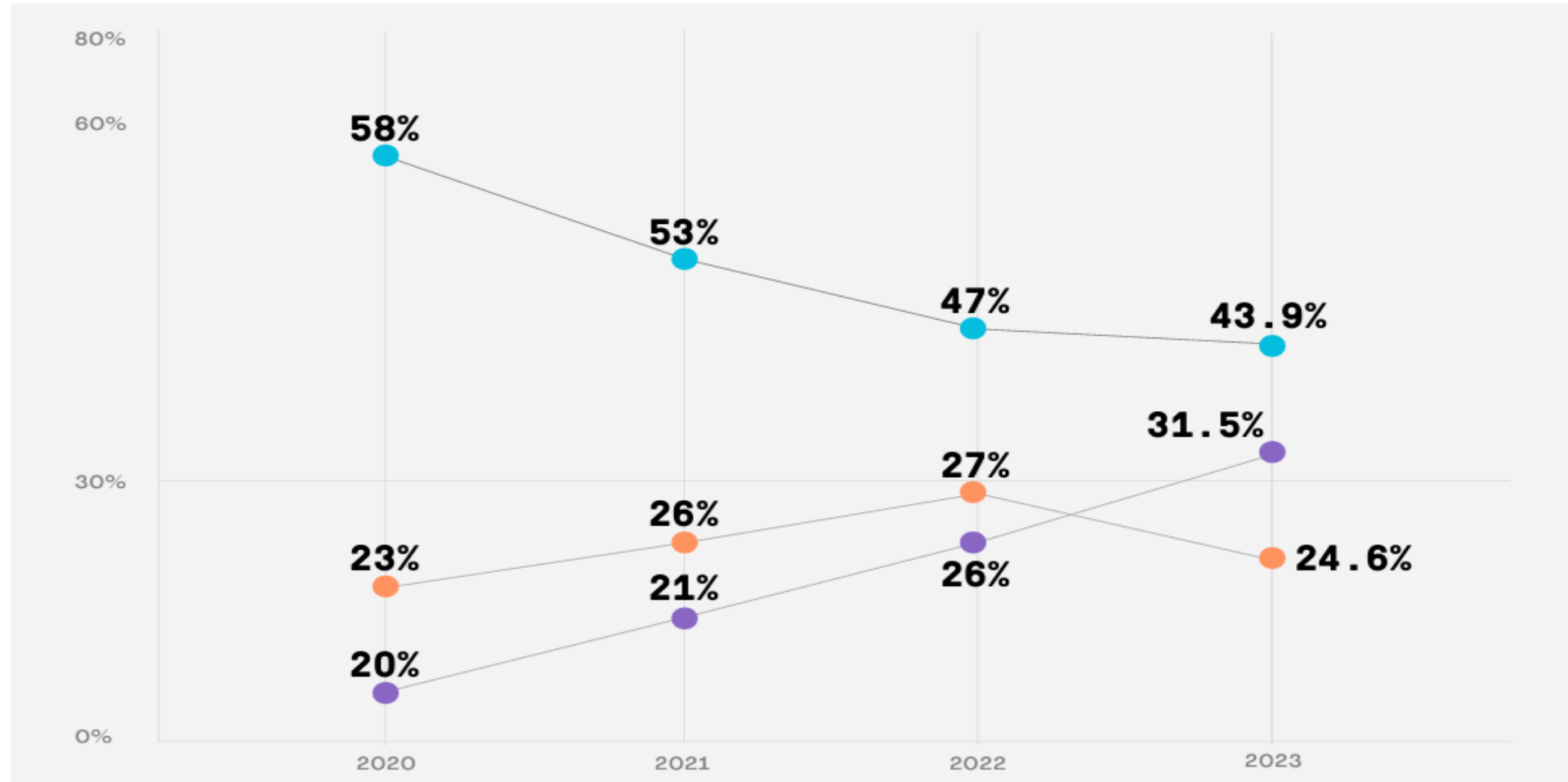

Benefits of Hybrid Method

Combining elements of both Waterfall and Agile provides several benefits:

1. Tailored approach
2. Easier Change management
3. Increased Stakeholder engagement
4. Increased Learning
5. Innovation and improvements
6. Helps sticking to budget and schedule
7. A way to try new methods

When to Use a Hybrid Approach

- In organizations with rigid processes, that want to maintain organizational controls and structure but still want the opportunity to improve and update the project as it is progressing
- Projects with aggressive delivery schedules, but also with the goal of quickly developing a solution
- Projects with strict deadlines but where changes are negotiable.
- Highly regulated industries
- Projects where agile is too flexible, but Waterfall is too rigid.



Best Practices

- Develop a VSM that integrates Agile and Waterfall
- Define what Agile and Waterfall practices will be used, when
- Include the entire team as well stakeholders in defining the process
- Clear communication with project team & stakeholders
- Collect, analyze and report relevant metrics
- Regularly review the process using frequent retrospectives

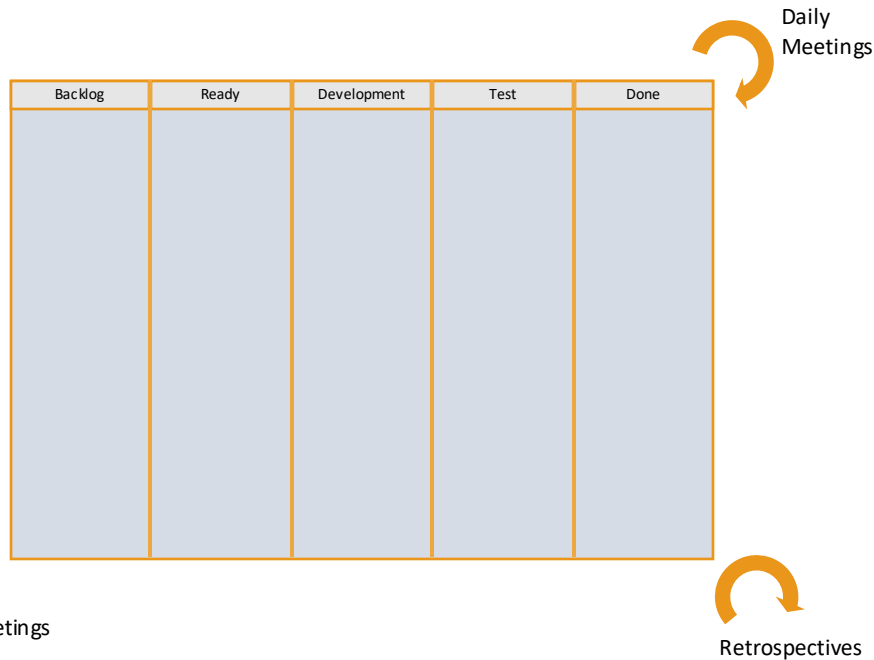

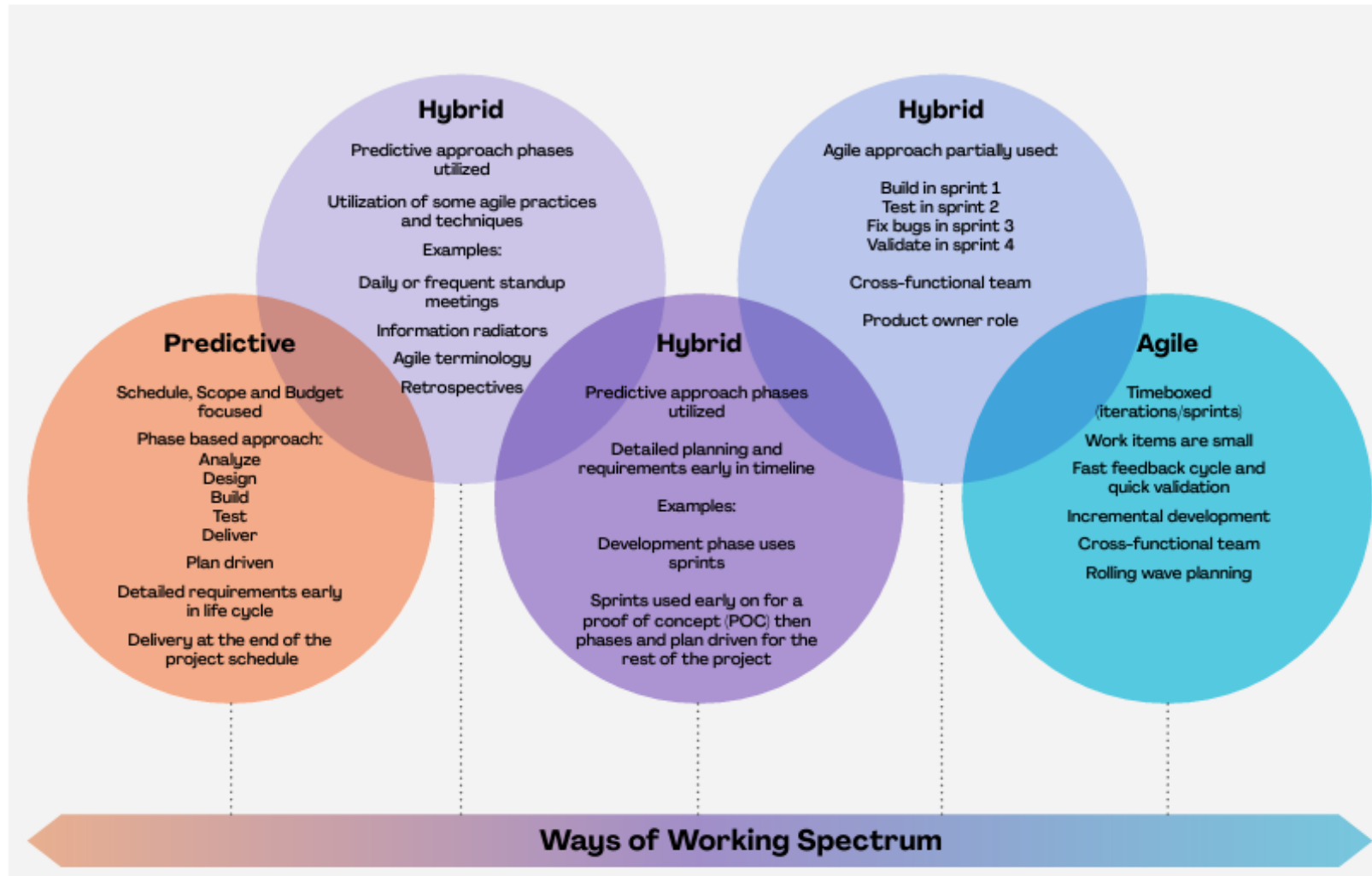

A Few Common Agile Practices

1. Maintaining a Backlog / Prioritized Requirements
2. Visualizing Work through Kanban Board(s)
3. Limiting Work in Progress (WIP)
4. Progressive Elaboration
5. Smaller Iterations
6. Daily Standups
7. Retrospectives
8. Frequent Review/Demos
9. Continuous integration (CI)
10. Iteration planning meeting
11. Planning poker
12. Refactoring
13. Writing User Stories
14. Test-driven development (TDD)
15. Use of Wireframes for UI Design

Common Agile Practices Incorporated

The most common agile practices that can be incorporated when using a hybrid model are:

1. Iterative & Incremental aspects
2. Managing requirements using a backlog & user stories
3. Prioritization
4. Visualization of all the work (using Kanban)
5. Product & Release Planning
6. Frequent planning and reviews
7. Retrospectives
8. Daily touch-base/standups
9. Limiting Work-in-Progress (focusing on finishing rather than starting)
10. Continuous grooming, development, integration and deployment

STEPS TO CREATE A HYBRID APPROACH

Steps to Create and Implement a Hybrid Approach

1. Identify Project Goals & Context
2. Visualize the project delivery process using Value Stream Mapping (VSM)
3. Based on the VSM, cocreate a fit-for-purpose Hybrid process picking up best practices from Waterfall and Agile
4. Identify metrics to measure & improve performance
5. Implement the new Hybrid process
6. Measure and improve continuously
