Digital Transformations Affecting PM, Agile Landscape

What is Digital Transformation?

- ✓ Using digital solutions for traditional business processes
 - For example: Online HR / payroll management
- ✓ Also includes ways to track customer habits
 - By tracking, companies can better predict customer needs




Digital Transformations — Implications for Agile / PM

Digital Transformation is Organizational Transformation

Organizations Need to Get Ready

- ✓ Readiness means identifying where digital transformation makes sense and how to get ready
 - For example, building a process to transition to digital time-tracking
- ✓ That's where BA/PM come in
- ✓ BA/PM can help build Digital Transformation Roadmap





Artificial Intelligence

What is Artificial Intelligence?


- ✓ Machine learning teaching machines how to think
- ✓ Predictive Analytics forecasting using data


Both could have powerful impacts on the Agile and Project Management worlds.



Artificial Intelligence – Implications for Agile / PM

- ✓ Machine thinking can help organize resources, scheduling by providing insights from historical data
- ✓ Predictive analytics could help with risk management, including alerting to risk triggers and identifying possible missing risks
- ✓ Both can simulate projects to help identify optimal outcomes and gain efficiency as well as proactively alert PMs to upcoming milestones and risks







Project Focus Shifting to Product Focus

Project Teams come together for one project and are dispersed after it's completed

In contrast, product teams come together to maintain a product and develop greater cohesion

✓ No need to make and break teams with product focus



Product Focus – Implications for Agile / PM

- 1. Switch to product teams from project teams to develop greater team cohesion
- Make sure product teams are end-to-end and have the resources they need to move forward with their product delivery (i.e. QA testers, BAs)





Shift from PMO to PMCOE

PMO – Project Management Office with tight focus on maintaining, improving project management practices

COE – Center of Excellence typically focused on business analysis

PMCOE – Project Management Center of Excellence incorporating Agile and BA ideas

PMO to PMCOE – Implications for Agile / PM

- ✓ Combine project management, Agile, and business analysis practices under one umbrella
- ✓ Use these practices to address enterprise-level needs
- ✓ Payoff in the form of greater strategic alignment, knowledge sharing, and focus on best practices



Room for Improvement in Agile Maturity


According to VersionOne's 12th annual State of Agile report, few business executives put a priority on Agile maturity.

Without Agile maturity, teams can start out great but falter later on, or not get started at all.

- ✓ Organizations need to keep track of their Agile maturity
- ✓ What practices are succeeding and what are not?
- ✓ How can Agile teams become fully self-running and empowered teams?
- √ Tracking maturity also enables teams to continuously improve

Lean/Agile and Scrum Being Used to Guard Against Disruptive Technology

Disruptive technology is any technology that provides an efficiency or cost alternative to established technology / approaches, threatening or "disrupting" the traditional approach.

- ✓ For example, Uber vs. established taxi services, or Netflix vs. video rental stores
- ✓ Many of these disruptive technologies succeed because they are more efficient than the alternatives.
- √ To gain efficiencies to guard against the effects of disruptive technology, Lean/Agile techniques such as Value Stream Mapping (VSM) and Kanban boards can be helpful.



Lean/Agile – Implications for Agile / PM

- ✓ Lean/Agile provides a way to realize efficiency gains through process improvement
- ✓ Gains can be as much as 15-40% in 4-8 Weeks
- ✓ Project management and Lean/Agile can be leveraged to spearhead process improvement projects
- ✓ VSM, Kanban, and Kaizen plans all help against disruptive technology by providing ways to realize efficiency.



Lean Portfolio Management


Lean portfolio management means shifting Lean practices such as waste reduction and process improvement to the portfolio level.

- ✓ Leads to greater alignment of whole business rather than different strategies for different lines of business
- ✓ Another benefit is greater visibility
- ✓ Like many transformation, requires heavy cultural change



Lean Portfolio Management – Implications for Agile / PM

- ✓ Budgeting becomes by value stream rather than by project, which can be a difficult transition
- ✓ Bottlenecks at organizational level have to be removed
- ✓ Culture needs to adapt to higher degree of transparency, visibility, and collaboration





Agile for HR

Agile mindset and practices can touch many areas of human resources, including the following:

- √ Hiring practices
- √ Roles and responsibilities
- ✓ Career paths
- ✓ Training
 - For example, training and career paths can become a product backlog that is constantly updated so role documents and training are recent, allowing for speedy response to landscape shifts.



Agile HR – Implications for Agile / PM

- ✓ Make sure entire organization has buy-in
- ✓ Culture of self-empowered teams needs to displace command and control
- ✓ Start with the leadership teach them how to be servant leaders and empower employees





Revisiting Last Year's Trends

- 1. More project managers needed by 2027
- 2. Changing Role of Governance
- 3. Need for Emotional intelligence increasing
- 4. DevOps Gaining Ground more organizations are implementing DevOps according to VersionOne's latest State of Agile report.
- 5. SAFe® Framework Gaining Ground 29% of organizations use SAFe as their scaling framework according to VersionOne's State of Agile report.
- 6. Greater Need to Communicate Value
- 7. Growth of Hybrid Approaches many organizations we've seen are still building hybrid approaches.
- 8. More Spending on Cybersecurity
- 9. More Remote Work/Virtual Teams
- 10. Education Continues to Be Important over 880,000 PMP-certified project managers as of February 2019




