
Project Management / Agile Trends

- Project managers need to expand their skillsets due to projects becoming more strategic
- 2. Importance of PMO will increase
- More organizations need to implement Project Portfolio Management (PPM)
- 4. Big data analysis is increasing
- 5. Emotional Intelligence remains as important as ever

- Agile will continue to expand into other functions such as HR, marketing, and operations
- 2. Focus on Agility at Scale will increase

1. Project Management Skillset

- 1. Skillset changes driven by increase in strategic projects
- 2. "One size fits all" PM is no longer the reality
- 3. Examples of new skills include Design Thinking, Rapid Prototype Development, Market Research, Analytics and more





2. Importance of the PMO

- 90% of surveyed organizations have a PMO,
 25% have a new PMO
- 2. More than just status reporting and templates
- 3. PMOs need to help their organizations increase their PM maturity by working with PMs and non-PMs





3. Project Portfolio Management

- Benefits Realization is increasingly important and PM/PMO can assist
- PPM and Resource Management are more often intertwined
- PPM can also help organizations prioritize projects for greater success





4. Big Data Analysis More Important

- Big Data impacting PM in areas including risk management, quality management, and planning
- 2. Data can help PMs answer key questions such as team size and formation, skillsets, and more
- PMs should look for tools such as MS Project, PowerBI, and more to collect and manage date






5. Emotional Intelligence Is Still Important

- 1. 58% of respondents in a TeleSmart survey said emotional intelligence (EI) is the strongest predictor of performance
- 2. El can help you manage others and yourself
- 3. El remains a powerful tool for PMs and anyone looking to become a leader



1. Agile Expansion

- 1. Agile is expanding from IT origins into functions including HR, Marketing, and more
- 2. Businesses are realizing the value Agile offers all throughout the business, not just in software development
- 3. Organizations seeking to implement Agile should look beyond the usual stakeholders such as IT








2. Increased Focus on Agility at Scale

- 1. Scaled Agile Framework (SAFe)[®] is now on 5.0
- Disciplined Agile is growing, driven by affiliation with PMI
- 3. Scrum@Scale is a new framework for Agility at Scale that is growing

3. Increase in Hybrid Approaches

- Hybrid of Agile and traditional PM is increasing among organizations
- 2. Many organizations use simple approaches for small or simple projects and hybrid for more complex projects
- 3. Organizations should look for the sweet spot of when to use each type of approach

4. Adopting Agile without Mindset


- 1. 75% of organizations surveyed by Agile Velocity were doing "Superficial Agile"
- 2. They may be doing Agile, but without being Agile, they are more likely to run into trouble
- 3. Successfully transforming to Agile requires a shift in culture, practices and attitude





5. Increase in Unqualified Coaches

- Unqualified Agile coaches will increase due to increased demand for coaches
- 2. They may struggle in implementing Agile properly
- Look beyond the skillset and see how much experience your Agile coach has, and what he/she brings for you


