



## Overview of new PMBOK® Guide 7th Edition

- 1. Released July 2021
- Much shorter than previous editions approx. 250 pages total
- 3. Describes a systems-based approach to value delivery, not process-based

✓ Focus is on delivering outcomes, not outputs

## What are Project Performance Domains?

1. The PMBOK® Guide 7<sup>th</sup>
Edition is organized into eight
Project Performance
Domains instead of ten
Knowledge Areas.

#### 2. Each Performance Domain:

- 1. Describes key project competencies
- Describes necessary skills / tools to deliver desired outcomes
- 3. Includes an Outcome-Check table at the end of the section with ways to measure the desired outcomes

#### 2. Communication Types








## Development Approach and Life Cycle

- Life cycle aligned to business, stakeholder value
- Approach that facilitates delivery cadence

- Project progresses in organized, coordinated, and deliberate manner
- Holistic approach to delivering project outcomes

- Planning time spent is appropriate
- Change has been adequately planned for



### Can We Still Use 6th Edition?

- Absolutely.
- If your organization thrives with the process-based approach, PMI recommends you keep using it.
- Think about how your processes can be tailored to drive outcomes over outputs.





### Is the New PMP Exam Based on 7th Edition?

- No. PMP Exam is based on Exam Content Outline.
- The Exam Content Outline (ECO) changes will drive PMP Exam Changes, not the new *PMBOK® Guide*.
- 7<sup>th</sup> edition may be a reference for the exam but do not expect the questions for the exam to come from the 7<sup>th</sup> edition.
