






Project Performance Stress

More projects cancelled








Financial Stress

- 1. General business impact
- 2. Project financials
- Less chance of successful contract renewal

Long-term:

More project uncertainty








Personal Stress

- 1. Layoffs
- 2. Losing your job
- 3. Double pressure of working, living at home
