



What Changed in Recent Times?



Pandemic

- COVID-19 caused uncertainty and delays in 2020 that still have impact in 2021
- Many teams had to become remote with very little warning
- Massively abrupt shift in ways of working
- Many teams are still figuring how to work remotely

Business Environment Changes

- Businesses creating more remote teams to enable development "around the clock"
- 2. Purpose is to reduce downtime and enable faster time to market
- Businesses can also save on real estate costs by adding virtual teams that work from home between \$5,000-\$8,000 per employee

What are the Challenges for Remote Agile Teams?



What is Lost By Going Remote

- 1. Frequent in-person contact
- 2. Hallway conversations
- 3. On the fly white board sessions
- 4. Access to Agile workspaces
- 5. Easy access to decisionmakers
- Going out for lunch/ coffee/socialization on the fly
- 7. Several collaboration opportunities







Dealing with the Sudden Shift

- Pandemic came on us practically overnight
- 2. Many Agile teams weren't ready
- Adjustment time was greater for teams not used to remote work







The Good News?

- Agile is built to welcome change, even disruptive and sudden
- Being remote doesn't mean losing productivity
- Virtual workforce employees' productivity increased anywhere from 10-43%

New Ways of Working (WOWs) for Remote Agile Teams



Develop Working Agreements

- 1. Everyone should feel good about the way they're working on a team
- 2. Team charter is a powerful tool
- 3. Charter/agreements should address many things:
 - a. Time zone differences
 - b. General availability/meeting times
 - Use of video and other remote tools for remote collaboration
 - d. Personal Preferences
 - e. Cultural Differences
 - f. More, based what team would like to do

Where teams are going to work?

- 1. Some teams may still be fully remote post-pandemic
- Most teams will have somewhat hybrid ways of working
- 3. Some team members may want to flex to work from home and office as needed
- 4. Coworking spaces or office rentals may be something that can help with flexibility







How do teams connect better?

- Think of activities can make teams feel included in the company – online happy hours, game nights, and many others
- Increased video time
- Flexibility to do unscheduled video calls as and when needed, including 1-1 calls








How else can teams be supported?

- 1. Many team members are tired physically, mentally and emotionally
- 2. Start Wellness programs
- 3. Extend mental health outreach and support
- 4. Finding ways to let team members express themselves and what they are feeling
- 5. Pep talks










Tools for Remote Agile Teams



Videoconferencing

- Most tools allow for big or small, highly interactive meetings
- Breakout rooms for small group discussions
- 3. Examples:
 - a. Zoom
 - b. WebEx
 - c. Microsoft Teams
 - d. GoToMeeting








File Sharing

- 1. Keeps documents in one place for ease of access and "one source of truth"
- 2. Version control allows rollbacks if needed
- 3. Examples
 - a. SharePoint
 - b. Dropbox
 - c. Google Docs








Visualization/White Board – Mural/Miro

- Digital workspace where teams can collaborate
- Teams can use Mural, Miro or a similar tool to plan and review work
- Teams can also use it for dot voting, value stream mapping, and many other processes

Visualizing the Work – Kanban Tool

- Kanban-based tools to visualize workflow and expose blockers/waste
- Empowers teams to work independently and manage the flow
- Examples:
 - a. Kanbanize
 - b. Trello
 - c. JIRA
