What are the Objectives of a Retrospective? The "Why" Part

- Find and plan ways to improve quality and effectiveness
- Enable team on their journey for continuous improvement



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Whereas sprint review is for inspecting team output, retrospective is for inspecting the team process





Best Practices – Before Retrospective

- 1. Collect metrics data (velocity, predictability, churn, cycle time)
- 2. Prepare the sprint burndown chart
- 3. Prepare a document for the team to share feedback/ideas in real time
- 4. Each team member should review past retrospective feedback and action items





Best Practices - During the Retrospective


- 1. Every team member participates actively and provides his/her candid feedback.
- 2. In the first 5-7 minutes (the reflection window), each team member reflects on the last sprint
- 3. Each team member enters his/her feedback/ideas on the retro document.
- 4. Columns include "What Went Well", "What Can Improve" and "Action Items/Improvements."





Best Practices - During the Retrospective

- 5. Each team member should put at least one item under each column.
- 6. Team members can second or put a +1 against an item already identified to reinforce it.
- 7. After this activity, discuss the sprint burndown chart with the team and generate more ideas.
- 8. After burn down, the team reviews the metrics and updates the retro document with feedback/ideas.



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Best Practices - During the Retrospective


- 8. Now the team can start discussing the feedback/ideas to get a deeper understanding of those and finalize the action items.
- 9. The action items should include at least 2-3 improvement ideas on how to improve quality and/or effectiveness.
- 10. The team prioritizes the improvement ideas and picks up at least one to add to the next sprint.





Best Practices - After the Retrospective

All the improvement ideas are added to the backlog, flagged as improvement ideas, and treated as other backlog items for the team to implement in future sprints.
