## Role of a ScrumMaster in Agile Projects



In Agile projects using Scrum, the key roles are the team, the product owner, and the ScrumMaster. The product owner shapes the product's vision and requirements so the team can create something with high value to the customer. The ScrumMaster shapes the team's adherence to the Scrum process so they can form self-motivating teams, perform at a high level, and evolve their process execution. While the product owner aligns the team with the product vision, the ScrumMaster aligns the team with the Scrum process. How the ScrumMaster achieves this alignment depends on his or her traits, key skills,

and specific roles, each of which we will discuss further in this article. **Read More.**


